

September 2021 To See Return of OELC's Many



The week after Labor Day will bring the return of a host of ministries that have been on a Covid-19 induced hiatus for the last $1\frac{1}{2}$ years. What follows is a list of some of our returning ministries and how & when we plan to re-introduce them.

<u>Weekly Worship Schedule</u> Beginning Sunday, September 12th we will be offering two worship services on Sunday mornings, 8:15 and 10:45 a.m. There will also be Wednesday Worship at 6 p.m. in the chapel.

<u>In-Person Sunday School</u> We will begin the 2021-22 Sunday School year on Rally Sunday, September 12th with the installation of teachers, blessing of students, and a send-off to begin the year during worship during the 8:15 a.m. worship service.

<u>In-Person Confirmation</u> Classes for 7th & 8th Grade confirmation instruction will begin with an orientation on Wednesday, September 8th at 6 p.m. in the sanctuary. 7th Grade will be taught by Pastor Hoadley and 8th by Pastor Lorenz. We will be looking to pair all confirmands with a mentor to help share their journey through confirmation.

<u>Visiting Partners</u> Pastor Terry will lead a reorganizational meeting for those who remain interested in taking part in this ministry as well as any who might like to know more about it. The meeting is scheduled for Sunday, September 19 at 9:30 in the Family Room.

<u>Friendship Club</u> We wish to resume with regularly scheduled activities throughout the year and are looking for ideas regarding events you might be interested in. Please help us brainstorm as we make plans for outings and activities here at church.

<u>Men's & Women's Bible Studies</u> We plan to resume both sessions and would be interested to know how current participants feel about the format, location & time, or subject matter. There is interest in adding another men's bible study outside of the regular work week.

<u>Chancel Choir</u> Rehearsals will begin Wednesday, September 8th from 6:45-8:00pm. Please see the note from Choir Director Dan Newman on page 5 for more information.

<u>Youth Programming and Meetings</u> Once Pastor Hoadley has settled in we will be planning a series of meetings early on in the program year in order to prepare for events and opportunities in 2021-22.

<u>Ushers, Lectors, Communion Assistants, Cantors</u> Beginning Sunday, September 12th we plan to return in full force with all who help to lead our worship services, including our confirmands who serve as acolytes, crucifers, and book bearers.


