

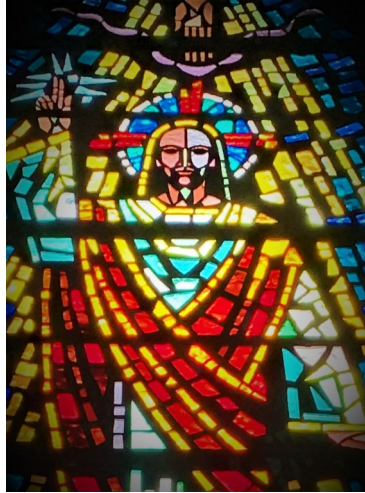

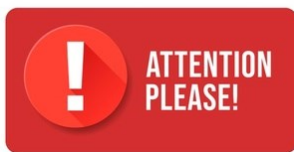

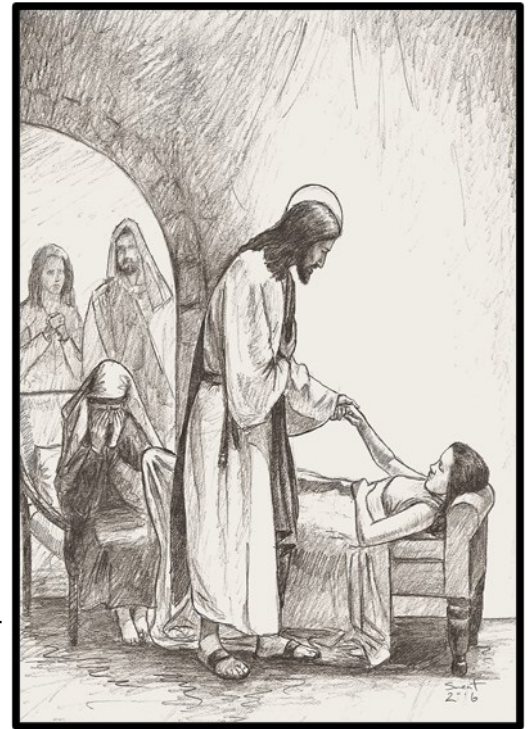

*Jesus took her by the hand and  
said to her, ‘**Talitha cumi**’*

It is, perhaps, one of a very few places in all of scripture where the exact words that Jesus spoke have been recorded and preserved precisely as they were first spoken, in the familiarity of the Aramaic language. Surely you suspected that the majority of what Jesus said all those years ago has come to us having been translated through various languages and enduring the ever-changing vernacular of a great many places. Even though this story is recorded in all three of the synoptic gospel accounts it is only the gospel writer Mark who retains remnants of the common language Jesus would have used among common people. And among the people, in the midst of a funeral for the daughter of a man named Jairus, is where Jesus takes the dead child by the hand and commands, “Talitha cumi” and a child of God arises from death.



In the similar setting of a funeral, celebration of life, or gathering at the home of a friend where death has been made known we would not say it quite that way in our time and place. Having the benefit of knowing Christ crucified and risen from the dead we might say, “Surely your spouse, your mother, your grandfather (you fill in the blank as needed) is a child of God whom Christ has taken by the hand and raised from death.

I share this interpretation and encouragement with you mostly because we have come through a very stark time of separation from one another and many of the rituals that bring meaning, comfort, and hope at times such as the one Mark writes of have been in a holding pattern until just recently. I don't think I'm the only one who feels a bit overwhelmed in trying to catch up with the funerals, celebrations of life, or visits to friends who are still grieving the loss of a loved one. Even though time has passed our family, friends, and neighbors still need our support and encouragement just as much as those who gathered around the family of Jairus' child long ago. Perhaps the most important thing we can convey in a visit, a card, or participation in a more formal ritual is our collective belief in the words Jesus continues to speak to the dead, “Child of God, arise.”

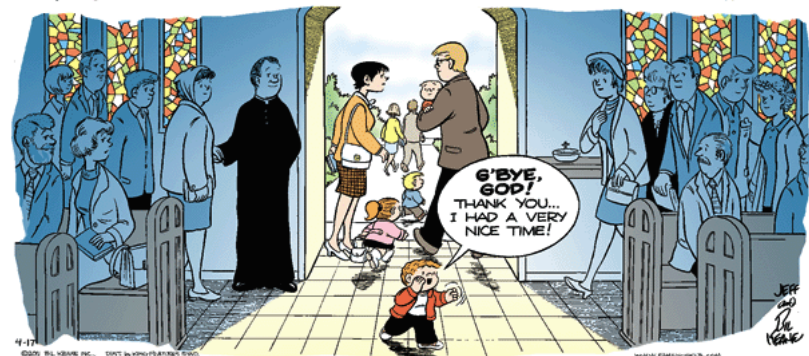

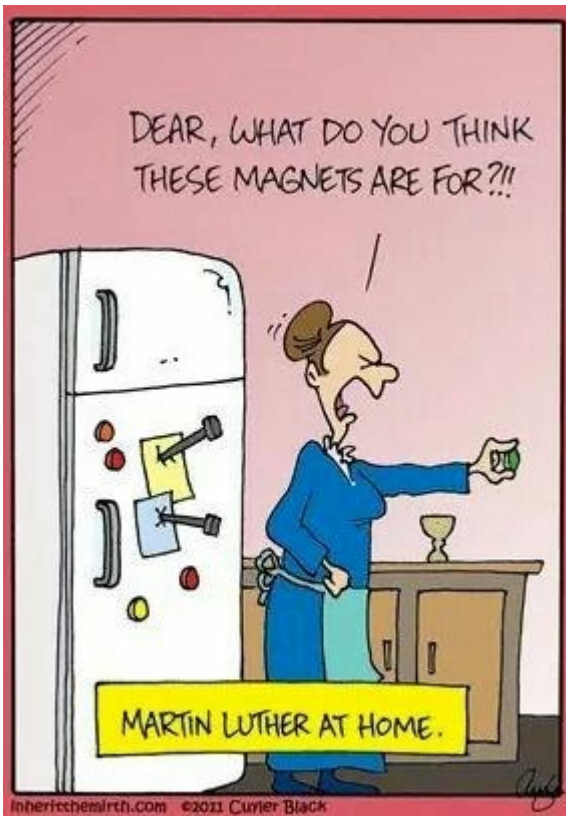
## We Rejoice in the Baptisms of...

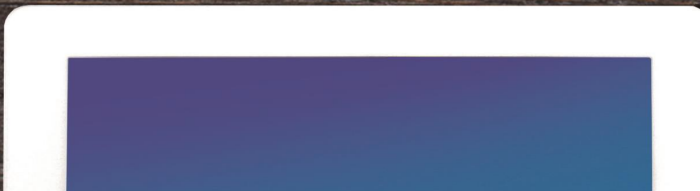
