You Need the Church (and the Church Needs You) excerpts taken from "Leading the Way" – uk.ltw.org

A recent study of 18-35-year-old Christians revealed that nearly half believe attending church is "not an essential part of their faith." The majority of those who do participate, do so primarily to grow in their faith (63%) and learn about God (61%), which may be why almost half of those polled attend church less than once a month. If you can stream the best preachers in America from your bedroom and listen to professionally produced worship music in your pajamas, why go to church on Sunday mornings?

When asked what is missing from the church today, these same Christians noted a general lack of relationship: my friends attending (18%), social gatherings outside worship (14%), support groups (13%), my family attending (12%), and regularly meeting with a mentor (12%). When so many neglect to meet together and consider the church as nonessential to faith, the whole body of believers feels their absence. The church is not meant to be a digital resource center for our personal and spiritual growth. Church was not and is not an event you attend; it was and is a community to which you belong that both refines and strengthens your faith. The church needs you, and you need the church.

We Cannot be Lone Ranger Christians – You alone cannot be the temple of God, but y'all can. At the center of the Christian life, God placed a community, a body. The Christian trying to proclaim the greatness of God alone is like the individual claiming to be a nation – a single stone claiming to be a temple.

And yet we neglect the church because living in community also means personal sacrifice. The appeal of an individualistic society is that everything is catered to our specific needs and desires. My music. My style. My age and stage. As a result, we treat church like a buffet for our own personal growth. We sample the sermon, complain about the under-flavored worship, and avoid relationships that give us allergic reactions. But the church is not a buffet; it is a family meal. We gather around the table together, break bread, eat from the same dish, and grow in our shared identity. This means our favorite entrée isn't served every meal, but that's not the purpose of a family meal. And that's not the purpose of the church either. *continued p. 4*

MUSIC NOTES Music Ministry and Me

Now that I am two months in as your new organist/pianist and Chancel Choir director, and hopefully temporary choir accompanist, I wanted to take a moment to tell you a little about my music background, approach to music ministry, and toss out potential possibilities as we move forward.

Let's start with a 60 second review of my music background. Music ministry days started in high school playing piano for the new "contemporary" choir. The church organist showed me some stuff and gave me a key (!) to the church so I could play around. On to college where I studied piano and voice, sang in choirs, served as a concert choir officer, accompanied many recitals, participated in Sigma Alpha Iota Music Fraternity for Women (professional, not social), and served as an officer there, too. My last 2 quarters of college I took organ lessons.

Right after I was hired for my first (of two) music teaching jobs, I was hired for my first paid church job as choir director. I spent the next 25 years teaching full-time and doing music ministry with piano and/or voice on and off, whenever the Spirit called until full-time teaching, parenting, life became overwhelming and then had to take breaks.

I have been fortunate to work alongside music ministers and attend a few workshops as well. It formed my approach to music ministry as just that...a ministry in the church. Music ministry done well leads God's people to practice our faith in meaningful and memorable ways, teaches one another the wisdom of God, and worships God with hearts thankful for who He is and all that He has done. (The Ministry of Music Ministry (tms.edu).) Message is the primary focus. Please pray that we may do music ministry well!



Lastly, I'd like to toss out possibilities and invitations for our future. Obviously, I am only one person and I believe no one intends for me to spend 24/7 engaged in church music. However, there are lots of ways to be involved in music ministry. Obviously, there is the Chancel Choir, and we need a couple of accompanists. As you may have already noticed, I like to include a variety of music in worship. Choirs, solos/small vocal ensembles, instruments, praise band for some Sundays, etc. Even if you have the tiniest niggle of desire to do something musical on an occasional or monthly basis, let's talk!


