As is often times the case with church traditions and practices, there is no real consensus regarding how and when Wednesday became known as the "church night" for much of Christianity. It's just always been that way I've been told numerous times by folks who remember prayer meetings, mid-week Advent and Lenten services, bible studies, confirmation classes, choir reheasals, church council meetings and a host of other activities taking place on Wednesdays.

Our church has hosted a number of the above events on Wednesdays for most of its existence, not the least of which is confirmation. Historically our confirmands would arrive at church by the appointed time to spend an hour or so in class and then be dismissed for home. More recently the structure has evolved to encourage the students (who attend O-F) to ride the bus from school and arrive by 3:30 or so, spend a half hour enjoying snack and free time, attend class for an hour, enjoy a light supper meal, attend our Wednesday Worship 30-minute service, and then be accompanied back home by family.

I am very happy to be able to offer such a wonderful, family friendly line-up for our confirmands who come to spend time intentionally preparing to affirm their faith in what God has done in Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

I am even happier to invite the families of our confirmands to take part in our Wednesday

Evening lineup as well. Please consider making

Wednesdays at OELC a part of your weekly routine by joining your confirmand for our evening meal at 5 p.m., and staying for worship in the chapel at 6.

What a great way to support your son or daughter as they seek to know Christ in a more intentional, mature way.

I've decided to write this month about "that" subject: money. It's not a subject I like to talk about and it's likely one you don't like to hear about. Often in churches the words "stewardship" and "discipleship" become buzzwords used in pleas for financial gifts; I recognize that there are many ways to be stewards and disciples that don't involve a checkbook, and the members of OELC are very generous with their time and talents.

The reality is, however, that general budget financial expenses for 2022 are significantly above offerings received. I believe I can honestly say that staff and church leadership are very careful about spending. It's no secret that costs are up around the world, and locally most folks know that utility rates recently increased here in Osseo. Businesses everywhere have had to raise prices to offset higher overhead costs. We don't have that option. We don't sell a product, so we can't just charge more to balance the books. We need to rely on your financial offerings to make up the difference.


A quick aside: It's true that the church's Endowment Fund has a large balance, but the stipulations of that fund limit the types of expenses it was meant to cover. That fund was not designed to be used for everyday operating expenses or salaries.


I don't know who gives how much at OELC. Nor do I want to know. A former pastor of mine said he didn't want to look out at the congregation and see dollar signs in people's faces. I don't know whether you are in a position to increase your giving; only you and God know that. I understand that many family budgets are equally strained by higher costs. I am giving voice to the situation and asking all those who call OELC their church home to please prayerfully consider whether and how they can respond. Our family recently raised the amount of our electronic giving and maybe you can find a way to do the same, however you give.

I'm proud of the ministry OELC provides in this area and globally and the reputation it holds in the community. I hope you feel positive about what we do, and I pray we as a congregation can continue to find new ways of spreading God's love in service to our neighbors. To move forward and expand our mission, we need those who can invest what they can to reduce the budget shortage. Thank you for all you do for OELC and the kingdom of God!

The Quilters meet the 2nd & 4th Tuesdays, 10 a.m.—4 p.m.


Bring a sack lunch. Everyone is welcome. If school is canceled, so is quilting.
