Two monthly grief support groups will be offered at OELC beginning in October 2023 and continuing through May 2024.

• A support group on death and grieving will be led by Pastor Terry on the first Monday of the month at 6 p.m. in the Family Room.

My intention is to provide a welcoming, safe, and supportive environment in which those experiencing the grief of losing a loved one may find solace and hope. I do ask that you consider attending as many of the sessions as you can as we'll be following a model and list of goals as outlined in a book written by Harold Ivan Smith entitled: *Death & Grief, Healing Through Group Support.* You need not purchase the book as we'll be using only select parts as well as parts from other resources. The support group on death and grief begins Monday, October 2nd at 6 p.m. in the Family Room

• A second grief support group on grieving life's losses will be led by Pastor Dave on the first Monday of the month at 1 p.m. in the Family Room, also beginning October 2nd.

The death of a loved is difficult, but it's not the only life event to bring about grieving. This group is intended to also explore some of the other times grief invades our lives, such as at the loss of a job, the loss of a relationship, moving homes, and even some positive transitions like retirement, marriage, and childbirth. Discussions and written exercises will help work through the emotions and hurdles that tend to be common in various grief experiences. All materials are provided. A regular commitment to the group is asked.






Who's preachin' today Pastor?

For most of my time in ministry no one ever asked me that question, if I was there, at church, I was always the one who would be delivering the sermon. Oh, it is true that once and a while a guest would be present and agree to join with me in leading the <u>service</u> but I never assumed that they came to preach as much as they came to champion their cause. Even if they told me ahead of time not to worry because they would work their cause into a sermon which they would be happy to deliver I never forgot the words Pastor Sherm Iverson shared with me long ago, "No matter who you think is going to preach, always prepare as if it were you." His advice has saved me from panicking several times. Someone may have suddenly taken ill, had the wrong date, or for some other reason just didn't show up for the service. Pastor Sherm's advice has been the impetus for a weekly routine in

which I am always preparing a sermon whether I'm on the schedule or not.

Come Sunday, September 10th, Rally Sunday and the day on which we return to two Sunday morning services and then one on Wednesday evening, you're going to notice a change in the answer to the question regarding who's preachin' today. Starting on the 10th I will be preaching on Sunday mornings, the first 3 or 4 Sundays of the month and Pastor Dave will be preaching the last Sunday of the month. While we will continue to lead together on Sundays he will be taking on, exclusively, leadership of the Wednesday Worship services. It is our intention to engage the help of confirmands in the planning and leading of those services. In the past few years, we have been trying harder to retain and engage confirmation students from



the arrival from school to worship on Wednesday night. Rest assured, no matter who climbs up into the pulpit, pastor or pupil, our intention is to faithfully proclaim the Good News of God in Jesus Christ.




